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## AUTOMATIC CREDIT CARD BILLING AGREEMENT

It is the member's responsibility to alert Roller Derby 360 LLC in writing if you are no longer attending practice due to injury or wish to resign from the league. Membership fees are non-refundable and cannot be reimbursed for partial months.

League-level skaters (both San Diego Derby Dolls & SoCal Derby) will be billed on the 15<sup>th</sup> of each month and will be on a 6-month renewal with membership terms from Jan 15-July 14 & July 15-Jan 14. If participant starts midterm, she agrees to the remainder of that term. League skater memberships may not be cancelled midterm unless participant has one of two special situations: Participant becomes injured to the point she requires surgery. She becomes pregnant. Either situation requires **written notice** to [payments@sandiegoderbydolls.com](mailto:payments@sandiegoderbydolls.com) to be cancelled. League skaters in leadership positions with comped dues must fill out a form for future authorization of uniforms and other incidental charges. No incidental charges will ever be authorized without written (emailed) permission.

Participants certify that they have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage they may cause or suffer while participating in, or activities associated with on-rink or off-rink activities. **It is required by Roller Derby 360 LLC (San Diego Derby Dolls) & SoCal Derby LLC that all on-skates participants carry their own personal medical and/or accident insurance.**

**EQUIPMENT AND SKATES:** Participants must wear the following mandatory safety equipment during all on-rink activities and practices: Knee, Elbow and Wrist Pads, Helmet and Mouth Guards. Eyeglasses must have plastic shatterproof lenses. The undersigned must take full responsibility that the above named participant (including self) is wearing the aforementioned safety equipment at all times while on skates and that it is properly worn.

**INSTRUCTION:** The training, opinions, findings, and conclusions offered are the speakers and do not imply medical expertise or acceptance of any liability. The materials and information presented are for informational purposes only & are not legal advice or counsel. Information gathered should be modified to fit your own personal needs, athletic competence, limitations, and state requirements. All skaters should execute proper safety precautions prior to attempting any skills demonstrated or shown. All participants skate solely at their own risk.

**MEDIA:** Members and visitors to the Dollhouse may be photographed or videotaped at anytime in connection with their participation in roller derby practices and events. The undersigned grants Roller Derby 360 LLC & SoCal Derby LLC the right to use their likeness in connection with their participation in Roller Derby 360 LLC & SoCal Derby LLC events in all media, whether now known or hereafter devised, throughout the universe in perpetuity without compensation, reservation or limitation.

**CONDUCT:** Spectators (patrons on the premises as a result of your involvement in the roller derby) as well as participants must behave in a respectful manner to both person and property. Behavior which could potentially lead to intentional or unintentional bodily injury or injury to property will lead to immediate removal from the facility.

**INDEMNIFICATION AND RISK ACKNOWLEDGMENT:** In consideration of being allowed to participate in any way in roller derby athletic sports programs, related events and activities in any way connected with my participation in, or activities associated with, this activity, or my use of Roller Derby 360 LLC and SoCal Derby LLC equipment or facilities, including any such claims which allege negligent acts or omission of Roller Derby 360 LLC and SoCal Derby LLC, the undersigned acknowledges, appreciates and agrees that:

1. The risk of injuries from the activities involved in this program is significant, including the potential for permanent paralysis and death, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury remains; and,
2. I KNOWINGLY AND FREELY ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS, both known and unknown, EVEN IF ARISING FROM THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE RELEASEES or others, and I assume full responsibility for my participation; and,
3. I willingly agree to comply with the stated and customary terms and conditions for participation. 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# MEMBER CODE OF CONDUCT

All members of the San Diego Derby Dolls and SoCal Derby are responsible for their behavior and are expected to adhere to all policies, rules, and expectations outlined for all Roller Derby 360 LLC and SoCal Derby LLC activities and facilities. Members are held individually responsible for the decisions they make regarding their behavior. Any conduct on the part of a member that has or might reasonably have an adverse effect on the proper functioning of the above listed organizations- or the health, safety, rights or property of the businesses, its members, volunteers, or fans- is subject to discipline. The Code of Conduct applies to all Dollhouse members on both San Diego Derby Dolls and SoCal Derby participating in league events, league and team practices and bouts. In this document, the term "league members" includes both active and inactive league members for both Derby Dolls and SoCal and all volunteers, officials and other people associated with the leagues.

## ACCESS TO TRACK

Member will have access to the skating track and facilities located at the Dollhouse at 841 14<sup>th</sup> Street, 2nd Floor, San Diego, California, 92101. Bootcamp level adults (including officials), Junior Skaters & Army must always have a member of the training team present and may be restricted to scheduled practices only. League level adult skaters (San Diego Derby Dolls & SoCal Derby) may come on their own to the facility at any time as long as they are accompanied by at least one other person who is capable of making a phone call in case of emergency.

## LEAGUE CONDUCT

Participation in the Dollhouse leagues implies acceptance by every member of the principles of mutual respect for the rights, responsibilities, dignity and well being of others. Code of Conduct in Derby Doll attire is also enforced during, but not limited to, fundraisers, promotions, and appearances on TV or radio.

- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Be guilty of an abusive verbal attack or physical attack upon any player, official, league member or spectator.
- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Appear upon the track (or on skates) at any time in an intoxicated condition. Drugs and alcohol use while on skates during practice (scheduled or unscheduled), games, or while working in an official capacity will not ever be tolerated.
- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Be guilty of discussing in a derogatory or abusive manner in any public forum, any play, decision, or his/her personal opinion of other players or league members. League members shall strive to support the league, team and group and uphold group decisions, even when the member may have voted against them.
- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Intentionally destroy or threaten destruction of property, equipment or grounds.
- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Publicly present obscene behavior. All Dollhouse public events are family friendly and must be presented in a PG manner including: bouts, public parties, PR events, media appearances and any event that involves ticket sales. Audible swearing, obscene gestures, mooning and other inappropriate adult behavior will not be tolerated at any public Dollhouse event/activity.
- NO LEAGUE MEMBER SHALL: Disclose Roller Derby 360 LLC, San Diego Derby Dolls or SoCal Derby LLC business practices, proprietary materials and information, including league documents to any third party without express authorization from the General Manager and/or Board of Directors.

## PLAYER CONDUCT

- Be courteous, friendly, positive and encouraging in interactions with leaguemates, opponents, officials, fans and sponsors. Players who display disrespectful conduct towards other participants may be immediately sanctioned.
- League members shall demonstrate good sports-person-ship before, during, and/or after practices and bouts.
- Treat everyone fairly (Derby Dolls or Non-Derby Dolls), regardless of gender, age, place of origin, color, sexual orientation, religion, political belief, economic status, team, or skating ability.
- Support the values of multi-ethnic and multi-cultural inclusiveness.
- Respect the rights, dignity, and worth of skaters, coaches, affiliates, sponsors, and fans.
- Limit competitive rivalries to game time.
- Be modest when successful and be gracious in defeat.

## OFFICIAL/REFEREE CONDUCT

- Know the rules and their interpretation and administer them.
- Be impartial in all decisions.
- Act in a professional and businesslike manner when acting in an official capacity of the league.
- Strive to provide a safe and sportsmanlike environment in which players can properly display their skating skills.
- Physical violence and verbal abuse will never be tolerated.

**MEMBERS UNDER 21**

- Will not be permitted to skate at any venue or function where the requirements are 21 and up.
- Cannot consume alcohol at any Derby Dolls function. This includes, but is not limited to: San Diego Derby Dolls events, Derby Dolls Member house parties, home or away bouts, and any gatherings with other Derby Dolls Members.
- It is the responsibility of the Derby Doll Members under 21 years of age to not accept or consume alcohol at any time.
- Should a Derby Dolls Member who is under 21 years of age consume alcohol at a Derby Dolls function, the underage member may be expelled from Derby Dolls.
- Should any Derby Dolls Member provide alcohol to a Derby Dolls Member who is under 21 years of age, the San Diego Derby Dolls Member who provided the alcohol may be expelled from San Diego Derby Dolls.

**PUBLIC IMAGE AND REPRESENTATION**

Members of the Derby Dolls are expected to uphold the values, missions and goals of the League. This prohibits speaking negatively of the League and its members and business partners in a public forum, including but not limited to broadcast, print and online interviews, as well as on any publicly viewable social media pages and personal blogs. The League and representatives of the League further protect players and other League members, to the best of their ability, from defamation, slander or false representation in print, broadcast or other media as it applies to the Derby Dolls, SoCal Derby skaters and Roller Derby 360 LLC. Derby Dolls league members may not represent the Derby Dolls at any event, broadcast, photo shoot or other non-derby endeavor paid or unpaid without clearance from the General Manager.

**GRIEVANCE POLICY**

In the case of any dispute or grievance deemed worthy of action, the General Manager and/or Board will assign a fair and impartial, uninvolved 3-person committee on a case by case basis to investigate and recommend a solution.

**DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS**

Disciplinary action, including warnings, probation, suspension or revocation of league membership, may be applied on a case-by-case basis for behavior that is illegal, threatening, or affects the league in a negative way.

**CODE OF CONDUCT AGREEMENT**

# SPARKS & WILDFIRES TEAM ATTENDANCE POLICY

Each month a skater must have a minimum of 16 hours of ON-SKATES training logged in order to be eligible to bout on Wildfires or Sparks the following month. Attendance policy applies only to San Diego Derby Dolls and SoCal members who wish to be eligible to maintain a roster spot and/or bout for Derby Dolls teams (Sparks and Wildfires).

## WHAT HOURS MAY RECEIVE CREDIT?

**Credit may be given for on-skates participation in any organized/coached skating that can include, but is not limited to:**

- All Dollhouse adult practices (formerly called SDDD league practice)
- All Dollhouse scrimmages (including Guys and Dolls)
- All Dollhouse team practices (Sparks, Wildfires, Kraken)
- Any Dollhouse on-skates coaching that is not given dues compensation (bootcamp and adult league practices)
- Extra small group practices that are coached with a minimum of 6 skaters (must be scheduled w/ Training Team Head for credit)
- Travel practices, scrimmages, and camps
- Pick up/open scrimmages/rec leagues outside the Dollhouse

**Credit will NOT be given for the following:**

- Off-skates participation
- Added practices that do not include a minimum of 6 people
- Added practices that were not pre-approved by Training Team Head
- Non-coached/pickup/session skating
- Park/ramp skating
- San Diego Derby Dolls or SoCal Derby bouts
- Any paid or dues compensated coaching position (ie. juniors, privates, open skate or travel coaching)

## WHAT IF A SKATER BECOMES INJURED?

- Player may not bout the month after being OFF-skates due to injury unless she has made her ON-skates attendance.

## REPORTING AND DISCREPANCIES

- Each skater will be responsible for signing herself in at the beginning of practice and reporting any attendance discrepancies with the Head or Assistant **within ONE week** of the date in question OR before the last day of the month (whichever is first).
- Any outside skating hours must be reported to the Head or Assistant **within ONE week** of the date attended OR before the last day of the month (whichever is first).
- If a skater is more than 15 minutes late to a 2 hour practice or leaves more than 15 minutes early, only 1 hour will be given.
- If an off-skates workout is included in a team or league practice, this will be counted as normal hours and will not be deducted from skating hours.

*I understand if I choose to play on Sparks or Wildfires I will be held to the above criteria and any required by the team captain in addition to these minimums including but not limited to minimum team practice hours.*

**2. FULLY UNDERSTAND** that: (a) THIS ACTIVITY INVOLVES RISKS AND DANGERS OF SERIOUS BODILY INJURY, INCLUDING PERMANENT DISABILITY, PARALYSIS, AND DEATH ("Risks"); (b) these Risks and dangers may be caused by my own actions or inactions, the actions or inactions of others participating in the Activity, the conditions in which the Activity takes place, or THE NEGLIGENCE OF THE "RELEASEES" NAMED BELOW; (c) there may be OTHER RISKS or SOCIAL AND ECONOMIC LOSSES either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of my participation, in the Activity.

**3.
